Entrepreneurship introduces society to new resources and new technologies, thus bringing previously unused or less used resources into the economy. It increases production by using existing production tools and existing inputs in different ways.

A newly opened or restructured company increases the country's employment volume, offers a solution to the unemployment problem, and as a result, economic development gains positive momentum. Entrepreneur; It accelerates the creation, dissemination and application of new ideas and leads to the birth of new industries. It accelerates economic growth because it creates rapidly growing sectors.

Approximately 25% of the employed population in Turkey consists of self-employed entrepreneurs. Again, approximately 60% of them work in a workplace as a wage earner, salaried worker or daily wage earner. When we look at the total population, only 6 people out of every 100 are self-employed.
